Prayer of Faith

The earnest prayer of a righteous person **has great power and produces wonderful results.**" (James 5:14-17, NLT) Emphasis added.

Scripture Reading and Prayer Prompts

At any time during the day that works best for your personality (e.g., morning, afternoon, evening), find a quiet place to rest in the presence of the Lord. Next, set an alarm or countdown timer (e.g., 15 min, etc.) and use the prompts below to help you quiet your mind of busyness and distractions as you wait to hear from the Lord during your quiet time appointment with Him ([Isa. 40:31](#)).

- Eight Keys of Effective Quiet Time Management**
- Welcome.** Welcome the presence of the Lord. Invite Him to speak into your life today.
 - Surrender.** Surrender your mind, will, emotions, intellect, and imagination to Him.
 - Scripture.** Listen to hear what Scripture reading objective He will speak into your spirit to pursue. Record your Scripture reading objective in the *Notes* section of the *Journal*.
 - Meditation.** Read the Scriptures aloud (or listen to an audio version of the Bible). Meditate on verses that touch or have an impact on you (e.g., repeat, transcribe, underline and/or highlight verses; make notations in a journal or the margins of your Bible of ways the Lord is calling you to personal application of the verses).
 - Worship.** Express gratitude to the Lord for revealing Himself and His word to you.
 - Confession.** Confess your weakness, God's strength, your need for forgiveness, and faith in the sacrifice of Christ.
 - Quiet.** Stop talking. Be quiet in the presence of the Lord. Listen to hear what He will speak into your spirit.
 - Intercession.** Conclude your time together by speaking or writing a closing prayer thanking the Lord for His presence, His word, and His heart toward you. Intercede on behalf of those whom the Spirit brings to mind. Accomplish what He instructs you to do.
